

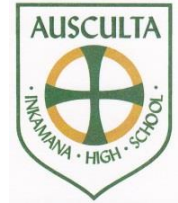

Requirements for the Inkamana Boys 2023

1. Dress Code for Inkamana High School

The school uniform identifies students as belonging to Inkamana High School. Students must wear uniforms at school and when engaged in school activities out of school hours.

It is compulsory to mark all personal belongings with the name and surname of the student - either with a sew-on tag or a laundry pen. No shortcuts are allowed at all – name and surname is required.

1.1 School Uniform – all marked

- Clothes bought for the school uniform must be from the **school's department** of any store.
- **Two pairs** of grey school trousers – Parents, please don't buy skinny pants.
- Short grey pants – not compulsory – for those hot summer days.
- Five white school shirts (long sleeved and short sleeved mixed).
- One plain black school jersey – available from Promo Direct or Screenworks in Vryheid.
- Five pairs of grey socks.
- One pair of black school shoes – no suede shoes
- Black school belt (no fashion belts are allowed).
- A black nylon rain coat with hood is compulsory.
- One black **good** quality Dri-Mac – not compulsory
- The school blazer is compulsory for Grades 10 -12 students for Sunday Mass, and all formal school functions and excursions – Available from Promo Direct or Screenworks in Vryheid. The school blazer is compulsory for Mass at the beginning and end of a term too.

It is compulsory to mark all personal belongings with the name and surname of the student - either with a sew-on tag or a laundry pen. No shortcuts are allowed at all – name and surname is required.

1.2 Sport Uniform - all marked

- Soccer boots - if a student participates in soccer – for all grades.
- Two black boxer shorts are compulsory – boys are allowed to bring more as it will be afternoon wear during the week – available with school badge from Promo Direct or Screenworks.
- The following are supplied by the school:
 - Team clothing for matches
 - Sport socks for matches

1.3 Afternoon clothing during the week

- Inkamana shirts = two green sport shirts, two grade shirts and one red / yellow team, black St Josephs' Shirt – available from Promo Direct and Screenworks in Vryheid
- Black Boxer shorts.

2. Hostel Requirements

2.1 Bedding

- Each student provides his own bedding to personalize his own bed.
- One pillow and two pillow cases.
- A duvet (plus one or two blankets that can arrive at the beginning of the 2nd Term).
- Two sets of bed sheets.
- Two small towels, a face cloth, toothbrush and comb.
- Two bath towels - with the name and the surname.

2.2 Toiletries and washing needs

- Soap, toilet paper, toothpaste, body lotion and deodorant and enough personal toiletries including enough tissue paper for noses.
- Material laundry bag – no plastic laundry buckets are allowed in 2022.
- Washing-powder for washing clothes & pegs for laundry.
- An iron in good working condition with the name and surname of the student, please test at home.
- If needed - shaving equipment. Razor and shaving soap suitable for a teenage skin – parents please check. If your child does not have a razor, please supply one. They are not allowed to share.
- Mark everything for your child, please.

2.3 Food and Utensils

- Spoon, fork, Mug, plate bowl - good quality plastic.
- A plastic container with a lid, size + / - 35— 45cm by + / - 20cm, where personal utensils, sauces and cereal can be kept in the dining room with a small number lock that fits the basket to lock it. Cereal (e. g .Corn Flakes) is popular amongst the students. Please do not buy lots of junk food - the students do get well balanced meals.
- Students are allowed to bring 2 sauces to use with their food. Students who would like to use a sauce with their food, must bring their own - borrowing is not allowed.
- Students are not allowed to keep food in their dormitories ever.
- No student may ask for food or sauces from another student. It will be considered as bullying.

2.4 Private Clothing to bring along – all marked

- Clothing should be suitable for hostel.
- Please do not buy expensive clothing.
- Simple but decent clothing. No fancy clothing will be needed. Not a lot of clothing.
- Two pairs of pajamas.
- Underwear for 7 days.
- One pair of bedroom slippers. Compulsory (for indoors)
- One pair of casual shoes/tackies.
- One pair of sandals / flip-flops.
- Three shirts/T-shirts.
- Two pairs of private shorts.
- One pair of private long casual trousers.
- One Jacket.
- No extra clothing is allowed.

3. Cell phones

- **Parents are responsible, at the beginning of each term, to register the cell phone that will be used during the term.**
- A student may only bring one cell phone to Inkamana. It is not compulsory to have a cell phone.

4. General

- All medicine must be registered by the parent on the form submitted on arrival - including prescribed, and over-the-counter medicine, vitamins, study vitamins, special creams etc. This form must be kept up to date if more products arrive.
- Three numbered locks & a trunk to keep personal items safe in box room.
- Mosquito repellent (e. g .Peaceful Sleep / Tabard / Mylol) is needed by all students.
- Pocket money is needed - but not a lot. Parents must please always give all pocket money to the hostel authority for safekeeping.
- Drawstring bags are allowed – no other bags will be permitted.

5. The following are definitely not permitted

- **Personal radios, computers and TV's are not allowed. NB: I-pods and Mp3's are permitted provided headphones are used.**
- **More than one cellphone is not permitted – at all!**
